(Seit vielen Jahren gab es in Tschechien diese nicht mehr).

We would like to draw attention of all the riders coming with horses to compete in the Czech Republic that **every horse has to be laboratory examined for Equine infectious anaemia with a negative result in the last 24 months!**

At the same time we would like to assure all participants in Czech international events and also national shows that no cases of equine infectious anaemia have occurred in the Czech Rep. for many years. This is just a preventive measure on the part of the National Health Authority.

Veterinary information for the horses coming into Czech Republic

All vaccinations must be put down in the FEI international passport or national passport approved by the FEI

EU Countries OE horses coming from EU countries don't need any customs document and may use any rout

As for the vet papers it is obligatory to use —Veterinary informationil (acc. 90/426EEC Annex

B) appended to the Schedule, or sent by e-mail

As for the vet papers it is obligatory to be provided with the certificates sent together with the Schedule or by-e-mail after the nominated entries
